

# *Terror on Every Side*

## Volume 1 – “Early Days”

Volume 1 was released in a second edition in both 9.5 pt and 10.5 pt paperback with extra resources. All undated errata and those dated before 28 June 2020 relate to the first edition which was withdrawn when the second edition was released on 28 June 2020. All of these errors were fixed in the second edition.

Page 163, Entry for Azariah [1], line 3: “Seriah” should read “Seraiah”

Page 165, Entry for “Elnathan – son of Achbor” is out of order and should be moved down three entries to replace the shortened entry “Elnathan [1]”.

Page 165, Entry for “Gedaliah [2]”, Line 2: “Nebuchandnezzar” should read “Nebuchadnezzar”.

In the following places, “Babylonian” should be “Chaldean”:
